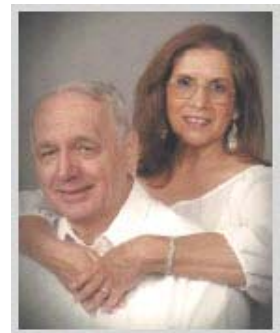

WHEEL-N-DEALS

Wow! September was a really busy month for Wheel-N-Deals.

We did our first “Flash Mob” square dance out at the San Marcos Farmer’s market on September 2nd. It was successful beyond anything we ever expected. We had an incredible amount of dancing support from the WND folks as well as from folks from Fun Dancers and Shirts-and-Skirts. Billy Graham from Lone Star Lambdas helped out as photographer and Rick Scofield from Fun Dancers, took and edited an amazing aerial video of all the dancers in action. (It can be seen on the Fun Dancers Facebook page.) Our beloved president, Billy Grimsley, did a phenomenal job calling interesting tips and leading audience participation line dances. Even non-participant dancers were smiling and clapping to the beat of the music.

We were fortunate to be set up next to KZSM San Marcos Community Radio. They were doing a live broadcast from the farmer’s market and Billy was interviewed. He was able to tell everyone listening all about square dancing in general, our club, upcoming lessons and our open house. At the end of the market, we went over to the KZSM station and Billy recorded a public service announcement (PSA). All the folks at KZSM were extremely friendly and helpful. “Quick Start” (aka Club 50) lessons started on September 14th with 7 students. Not as many as we had hoped but they all are very interested in learning MWSD and becoming members of our club. We also picked up 2 new very experienced dancers who plan to join our club in a few months. We met them at the Farmer’s Market while preparing for the Flash Mob.

Our Ice Cream Social was a total success. There were 7 different flavors of homemade ice cream as well as multiple toppings, cookies, and cakes. We put the ice cream out after the 3rd tip. Next year we will have the ice cream feed before the dance so everyone has 2 hours to burn it off. Even though we had a wonderful turnout of dancers, there was so much ice cream, much of it was taken home.

Wheel-N-Deals has its eye on the \$200.00 visitation prize to be awarded at the Mid-Tex dance by ASRDA. We have received 2 visitation certificates so far – both times visiting Come and Take It Squares in Gonzales. Many of the WND members have been participating in the Plus Club in New Braunfels on Monday nights and either taking Plus lessons or being angels on Tuesday evenings. These commitments limit the number of clubs we can visit in a week. Once the

Plus lessons end, we can start visiting clubs that dance on Tuesday evenings AND WND will have 4 new Plus dancers!

October 26th is our Halloween dance. Many club members love Halloween so are eager to make this a fun and very unusual dance. Chet Miles will be “howling” squares. There will be “Scary Snacks” and “Alarming Line Dances”, and Prizes, Prizes, Prizes! Costumes are highly encouraged. Our flyer is included in this ASRDA newsletter.

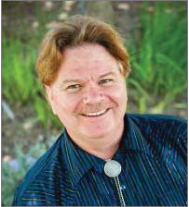
