FunDancers is happy to welcome Bob Martens as the new Vice President of FunDancers. Bob's main responsibility will be coordinating Mainstream and Plus lessons and working with the students. Bob is a great problem solver and has already come up with solutions to issues that have been brought to his attention.

Clarissa's husband, Anthony, is a 90% Disabled United States Army Combat Veteran who served 15 years and 3 Tours in Iraq protecting America's security interests. Dancers were very generous with their donations of cash and checks totaling \$1,713 from the FunDancers dance and \$125 from San Antonio's Alamo Area Association Herman Sons Square and Round Dance Clubs. One dancer was even able to put Anthony in contact with a woman working for San Antonio's USO that helps military Veterans transition into the civilian workforce. Once again, the square dance community came together to help some of their own.

Our callers for November are Brad Caldwell on 4 November, Bob Asp on 11 November, and Joey Duhamel on 18 November. We are DARK on 25 November for the Thanksgiving holiday. Join us at the Fun Palace and help Santa learn to dance!

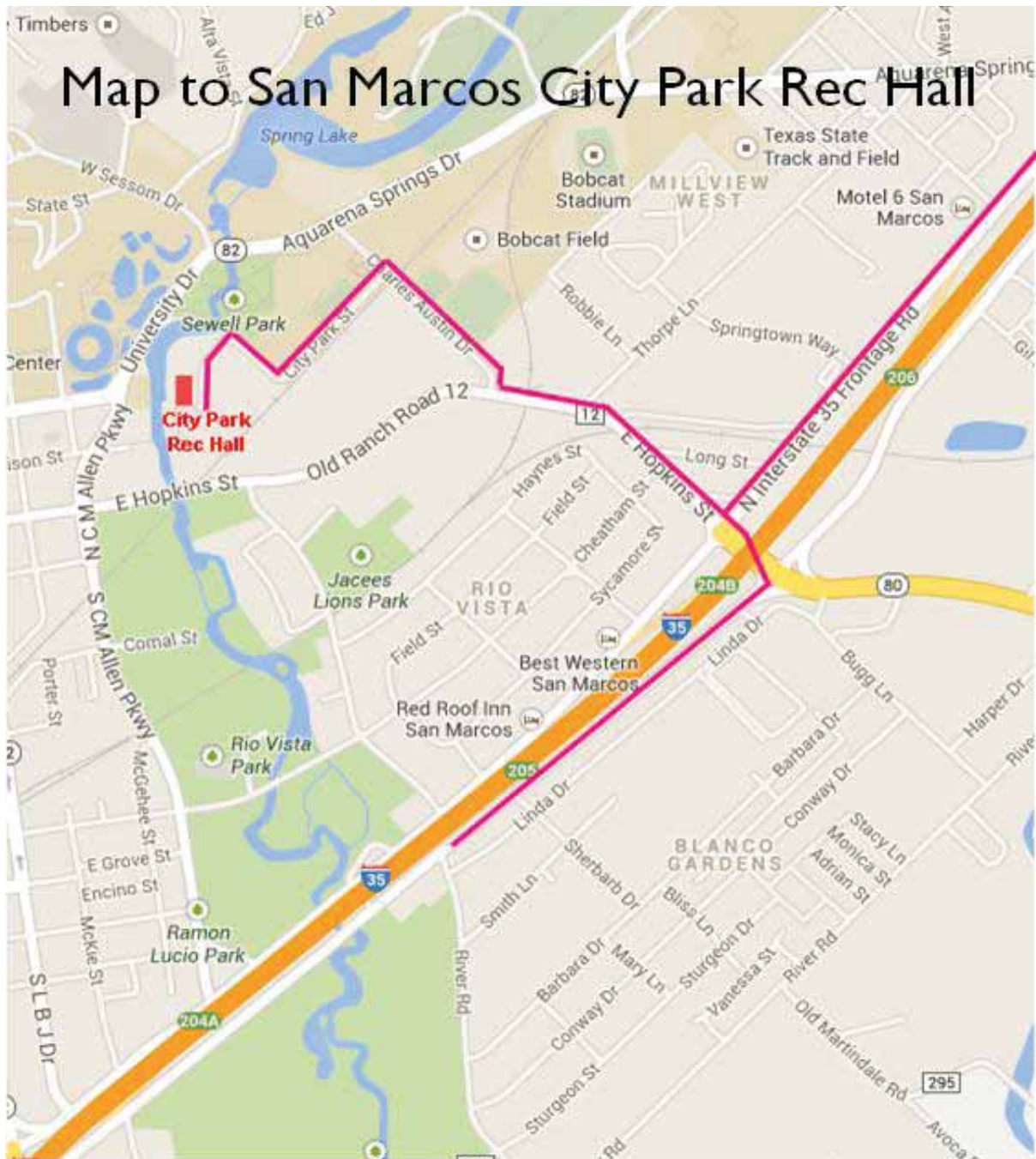
