

To sign up for this tour you need to let the Ski's know as soon as possible and give them your deposit for this tour. This will include your tickets for the Passion Play. We only have 6 tickets for the Passion Play and once we receive individual deposits for this tour, they will be gone. We will not be able to purchase any more tickets.

Tickets were limited when we purchased them in September, and we are sure they are sold out by now.

Tickets are reserved for the center of the theater. Tickets are a Group 2 Ticket.

We will accept a least one couple as a "Stand-by" in case someone cannot make this tour due to an emergency, at the last minute.

If you need more information about this tour please contact us. We have a complete breakdown of the cost from the previous tour we took in 2018 that we can provide you.

This tour should cost less than \$7,500.00 plus airfare per couple. This would include all your lodging, meals, snacks, tours and entrance fees. I arrived at this figure from the cost we incurred on the previous tours. This does not include souvenirs you purchase.

This is a little bit higher than previous tours, but we have to figure in the Passion Play cost. When we went to the Passion Play in 2010, the play was a lot more expensive because we purchased the package from the city. We have been able to purchase the tickets and arrange the accommodations (within walking distance of the theater), on our own. This has led to a substantial savings.

Once the Tour is full, and I have received all the deposits, I will start making hotel reservations for this tour. Many of the hotels will be ones we have stayed at before. Most of these will be smaller, privately run hotels. There will be times when I will have to pay for the rooms up front, when I make the reservations. When this happens, I will notify everyone going of the cost of the hotel reservation and ask for a check for your portion of the room. We have not had any problems doing this in the past. Once all the rooms are confirmed I will send you a listing of all the hotels with the telephone numbers.

We will have to make reservations for some of the tours that you will/or might want to take. I will let you know which tours and the cost so you can let me know if you are or are not interested. I will then make the reservations for that tour. In the past I have not had to pay for the tickets when making the reservations.

As we make our plans, we will be sending you more information on the Tour. We will also pass on helpful hints that will make your traveling with us more enjoyable.

We have completed over 20 tours to Europe with some couples taking 3 of our tours and 3 couples are planning to take the 4th tour, different from the other three, in the Spring of 2020. If you would like references about our tours please let us know and we will gladly provide them to you.

2020 Tour Itinerary

- 22 Sep Tues Depart the States for Frankfurt, Germany
- 23 Sep Wed Hanau: Arrive at Frankfurt, sightseeing in Hanau and going to a farmer's market, shopping and lunch in town before arriving at our hotel for the night.
- 24 Sep Thu Heilbronn: Depart Hanau, driving along the Neckar River, stop at a Crystal Factory for a short break, and then on to the walled city of Bad Wimpfen for some sightseeing and a snack. After that we will drive to our hotel nestled in the center of the vineyards. Our evening meal will be with German friends.
- 25 Sep Fri Kornwestheim: Depart for a relaxing drive along the Neckar River and the Vineyards of Baden Wurttemberg, arriving in the Stuttgart area in the early afternoon to attend the 2nd largest bier festival in Germany, second only to the Munich October Fest.
- 26 Sep Sat Triberg: Traveling through the Black Forest we will stop at an open-air museum, consisting of old houses and farms from the different areas of the Black Forest. Then on to the City of Triberg for Clock Shopping & the Water Falls (highest in Germany). Then off to the hotel for the night.
- 27 Sep Sun Holzgau: Depart Triberg for Schaffhausen, Switzerland, where the Rhine River starts it's way through Germany from the Alps. Then on to Vaduz, capital of Liechtenstein, for some sightseeing and a snack, From there to Austria driving through the Alps before stopping for the night.

28-30 M-W Oberammergau: Depart Holzgau stopping at Neuschwanstein Castle, the fairy tale castle of Disney, then on to Oberammergau, where you will have tickets to attend the Passion Play. We will also stop and visit Linderhof Castle. We will plan on doing laundry on one of these days.

1 Oct Thu St Johann: Depart driving thru the Alps into Austria, stopping at the Swarovski Crystal Factory and Museum. Prior to arriving at our hotel, you will have the option of taking a gondola ride up one of the many ski lifts in the area,.

2-4 Oct F/S/S Berchtesgaden Area: Depart for Ramsau, stopping at a working Salt Mine and the Eagle's Nest. We will also visit Salzburg, Austria, Konigsee, a Schnapp's Brewery for some free samples, & other sites of interest.

5 Oct Mon Munich: After a short drive to Munich, we will go to our hotel prior to taking public transportation into Munich for sight-seeing. We will end the day at the Hofbrau House for dinner prior to returning to our hotel.

6-8 Oct T/W/T Prague: Leave Munich, stopping at Dachau Concentration Camp prior to traveling to Prague CZ. We will check in at the hotel prior to going into the city center for dinner.

9 Oct Fri Pilsen: Travel to Pilsen, the World Capital of Bier, stopping at a crystal factory where you will be able to walk thru the factory and watch several employees busy producing crystal items. Then it's on to Pilsen CZ and the world-renowned brewery for a tour.

10-11 Oct S/S Eschenbach: Leave Pilsen for Grafenwöhr Germany. A relaxing drive with the possibility of doing laundry in the afternoon. On Sunday morning we will attend church in an old monastery. The afternoon is for relaxing prior to our final week of fun.

12 Oct Mon Rothenberg: Crystal Factory Shopping and then to the old walled city Rothenberg, sampling the local pastry and visit the many places of interest.

13 Oct Tue Depart Rothenberg for Heidelberg traveling through the Oldenwald Forest. We will stop in some small walled towns on the way.

14 Oct Wed In the morning we will go to Heidelberg Castle. After the Guided Tour we will go to Old Town Heidelberg, home of Heidelberg University, where we will have free time for sightseeing and shopping.

15 Oct Thu Wiesbaden: After breakfast we leave for the Rhine River Cruise. After the cruise we will travel the Rhine River Road to the hotel. There will be last minute shopping and packing. Later in the evening we will have a farewell dinner at the hotel.

16 Oct Fri In the morning we depart for the airport for your return flight home.
