Unfortunately, we do not have access to Hill Country Bible Church gym this fall, so we will not continue dancing there on Sunday afternoons. #### CLICKETY CLOGGERS

This year is the Clickety Cloggers 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary, so it is a fitting time to reflect back on our clogging history and how it has intersected with square dancing along the way.

The Clickety Cloggers was founded after a group of square dancers went to the National Square Dance Convention in Anaheim, California, in the summer of 1976. The majority of these people were from the Southside Swingers Square Dance Club, which held their weekly square dance at the Municipal Golf Course Club House on Enfield Road and Exhibition Drive. Among the original charter members were Jimmy and Gwen Johnson.

Even back then, Jimmy was a square dance caller. Gwen choreographed some of the club's early clogging routines. Although our performance clogging routines are constantly changing and evolving, we continue to use many square dance figures in our shows.

As original members left, the club fell on hard times and was reorganized in 1989. Previously, it had been primarily an exhibition team under the leadership of one person. In the revived Clickety Cloggers, leadership was divided among several people and dancers could be club members or, in addition, join the exhibition team. Also, new dance routines and beginner lessons were now being taught in club.

Starting around 1990, the Clickety Cloggers began sharing occasional performances with square dancers at Mid TEX during the breaks. Then in 2005 Clickety Cloggers officially joined ASRDA. Our members have also taught clogging at the State square dance convention a number of years.
