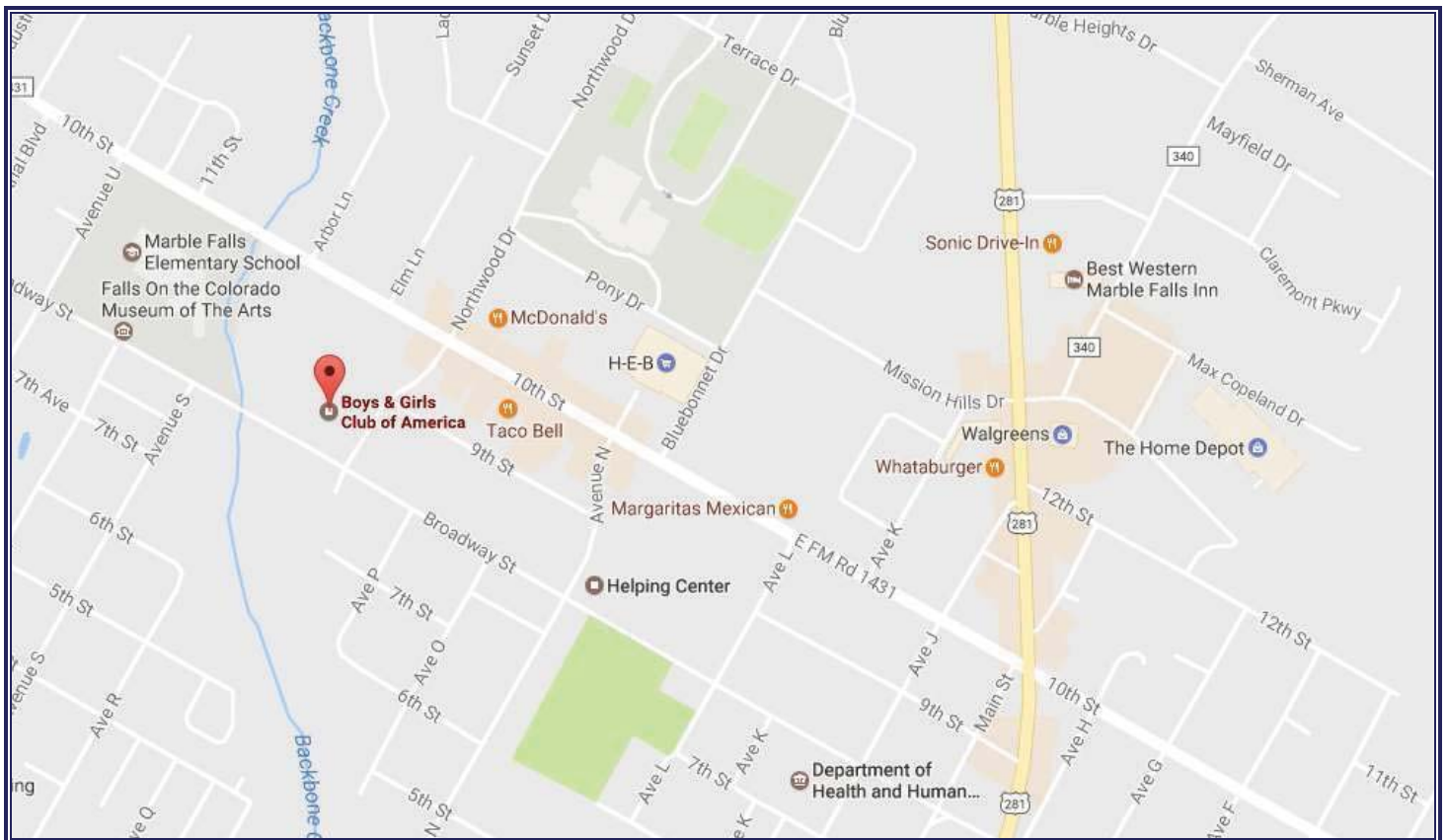

News about Abby, my sweet, attractive granddaughter's cancer shook the family to the core. Several doctors prescribed various treatments without success. A trip to Oklahoma's cancer hospital discovered a most serious form of cancer and recommended treatments of radiation and chemotherapy. Abby soon lost her long golden tresses and considerable body weight.



In a short time this lovely vivacious mother and wife, became weak, unable to care for herself and needed help with routine body functions. After more than a year's pain and anguish, exams and scan results indicated the tumor is shrinking. Abby's devoted husband, his family, my son and extended family are beleaguered by associated medical costs not covered by insurance.



More unwelcome news came for me over the Christmas season. The VA initially diagnosed my persistent cough as bronchial pneumonia. A stream of antibiotics and shots yielded no results. My doctor advised me to check into the hospital for tests. After nearly a week, I underwent a procedure that stopped the cough and cleared the lungs. However, exam results confirm it is small cell lung cancer. I too, will experience a long journey with chemotherapy. My granddaughter and I now have much in common with stories to share.

This Benefit Dance fully demonstrates the love, support and giving nature of our square dance family. For me, words fall far short of the gratitude I feel and want to express toward everyone. Your sincere prayers, your kind thoughts and behavior toward promoting this very special event are far more than I could ever hope for.

I feel truly blessed my life has brought me to so many wonderful friends. Thank you Jesus! And thank you all so very much.

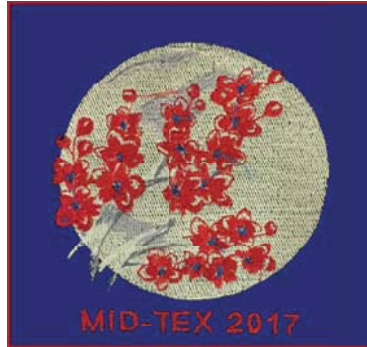

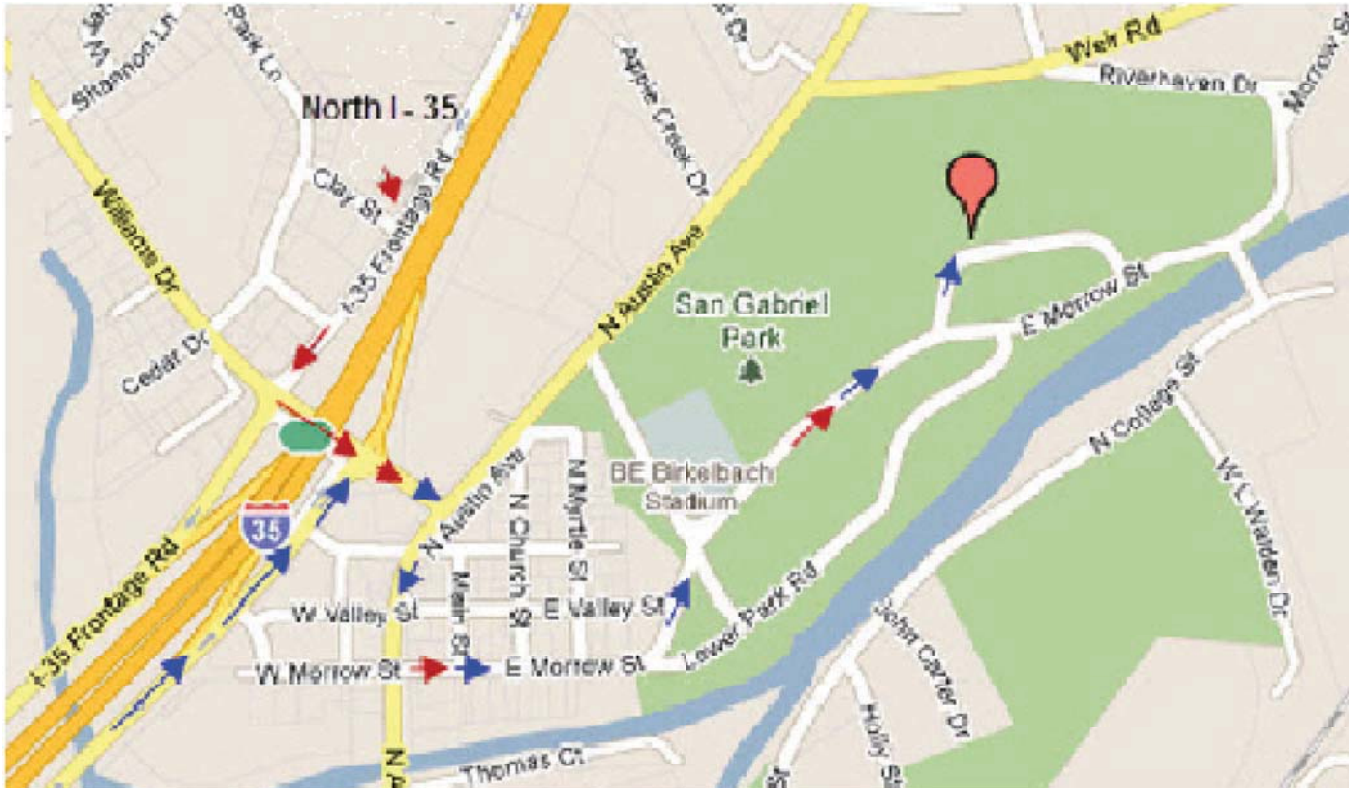

I-35 North from Austin (about 29.7 miles): Take exit 262 and stay on access road for 1.3 miles. Go up to the signal and turn right on Williams Drive (RR-2338). Go about 400 feet to signal and turn right on N Austin Avenue. Drive 0.2 mile and turn left at the signal across the street from Sonic on E Morrow Street. Stay left on E Morrow Street for less than 1 mile to arrive at 445 E Morrow Street.

I-35 South from Temple (about 40.5 miles): Take exit 262 and follow the access road past the La Quinta Hotel and turn left on Williams Drive (RR-2338). Drive right on N Austin Avenue. Drive 0.2 mile and turn left at the signal across the street from Sonic on E Morrow Street. Stay left on E Morrow Street for less than 1 mile to arrive at 445 East Morrow Street.

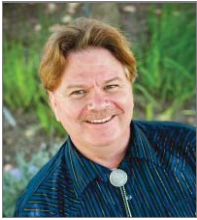
