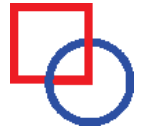

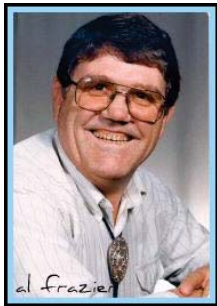

In the short 6 years Ed square danced, he became very active in the leadership and management end of the activity. He was president of the FunDancers from 2012 to 2014, and initiated the club's Annual Independence Day Cookout with a no-cost meal to all square dancers attending from around Texas.

For the 2014-2015 period, Ed was President of the Austin Square and Round Dance Association (ASRDA). During this time, he championed an initiative that was approved to provide individual ASRDA clubs with an annual \$200 gift to pay for any activity or event that would promote the club's publicity toward attaining new membership.

Ed was a fun loving type of guy with a good sense of humor. He lived life to the fullest and was always available to help any square dancer in need of assistance. Ed owned his own solar screen business in New Braunfels, Texas and had a fondness for western dancing and motor scooters.

Ed's humor and laughter will be missed by all of those who knew him.

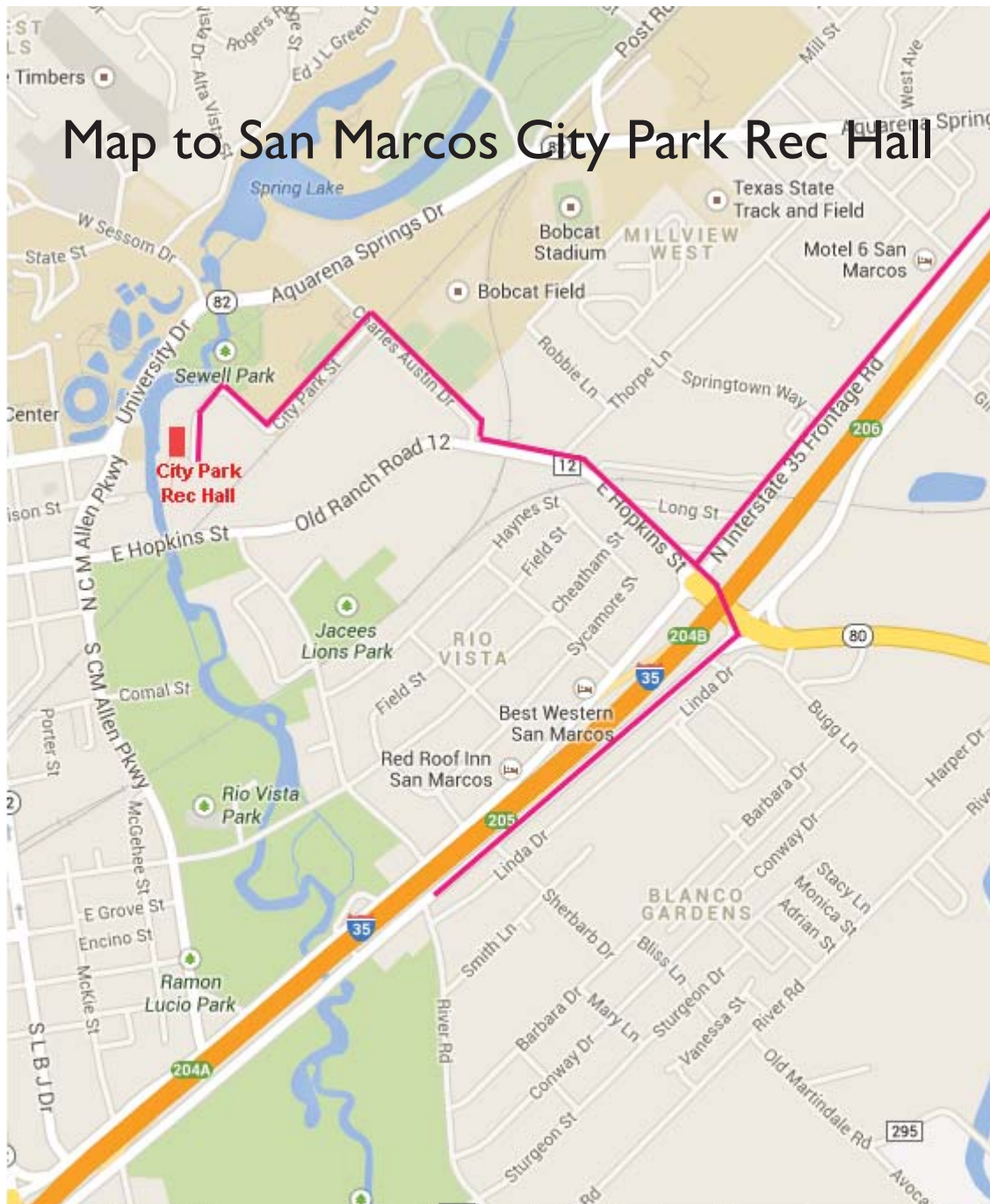

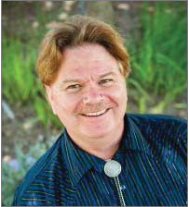

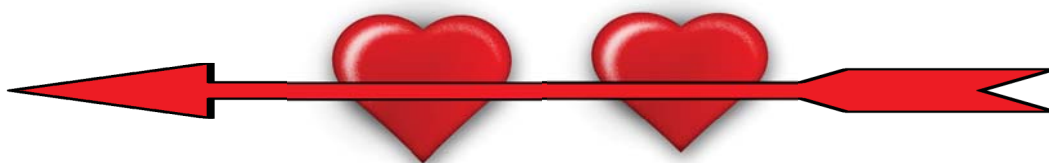
