President's Message

Every song he played, in some way, had an island theme. Ron Plouch even found some island music for rounds. Dancers took advantage of the Clothes Closet to pick out new outfits. My thanks goes out to everyone who helped with opening and decorating the hall, food preparation, and clean-up.

MARK YOUR CALENDARS! Our next ASRDA dance will be the Teen Scholarship Dance on **November 9th, 2019. This a change from our original date.** Chet Miles and Brad Caldwell will be calling and Lucy and Jerry Pate will be cueing. All four of these folks are donating their talents for the evening. This year the Teen Scholarship Dance will have a theme. We are encouraging people to come dressed like they did when they were teens or their interpretation of how teens dress. Square dance attire is also acceptable. Brad and Chet are compiling music teens listened to in different eras. Snacks will include pizza, hot dogs, chips, soda. If dancers want to bring additional snacks or desserts, we are encouraging them to bring a snack or dessert they ate as a teenager. The Clothes Closet will be open for business. All proceeds from the dance and Clothes Closet will be donated to the Teen Scholarship Fund. (Flyer is included in this month's newsletter). We are now headed into fall which means the beginning of square dance lessons. I know the clubs offering lessons have been promoting lessons for the past few months. Hopefully all clubs will have a great turnout.

In one of the recruitment and retention classes I took at the National Square Dance Convention, I learned about the "Marketing Funnel." It demonstrates the process a consumer goes through in deciding whether or not to buy a product (in our case – square dance lessons). The first and most important part of the Marketing Funnel is AWARENESS. If the consumer doesn't understand the product and how it solves a want or need they have, they will not buy what you are selling. Our job when promoting square dancing is to let people know what square dancing is TODAY and which of their needs it meets. According to several instructors at the Leadership Development course, the major need square dancing meets is SOCIAL CONNECTION. Of course we know that it offers so much more. You will be more successful recruiting new dancers if you know and address the needs of the consumers you are targeting. Promoting square dancing isn't something that should only be done a month before your club starts lessons. It should be done 12 months a year. People have to be exposed to a product or idea a minimum of 7 – 10 times before they will move from the "Awareness" phase into actually considering buying the product. Ways of increasing awareness are almost endless. Examples include demonstration dances, flyers, articles in newspapers, social media, community involvement, parade floats, signs in front of the hall where you dance, and many more. A very complete list can be found on-line under Jim Langdon's "Prospecting Ideas – 174 Ways to Find and Retain New Dancers." CALLERLAB's "Square Dance Marketing Manual" is also an excellent reference.

My main goal for this year is to help clubs raise awareness of square dancing throughout the ASRDA community and beyond. I really believe this will help recruitment and retention.

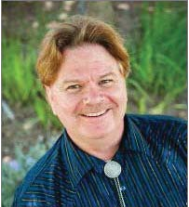
